

RING SIZING

HOW TO MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE

Ideally one should measure their finger by a professional jeweler using a ring sizer. If that is not possible, you may do the following to get an estimation.

- Find a piece of floss or string.
- Wrap it around the base of the appropriate finger.
- Use a pen or marker to mark the point on the string where it overlaps, forming a complete circle.
- Using a ruler or tape measure, measure the length from the starting point of the string or floss to the pen mark.
- Now we can determine your size with the chart below.

G – 45.5mm	P – 56.3mm	EXTRA SMALL: J - K
H – 46.7mm	Q – 57.6mm	SMALL: L – M
I – 48mm	R – 58.9mm	SMALL MEDIUM: N – O
J – 48.7mm	S – 60.1mm	MEDIUM: P – Q
K – 49.9mm	T – 61.4mm	LARGE: R – S
L – 51.2mm	U – 62.7mm	EXTRA LARGE: T - U
M – 52.5mm	V – 64mm	
N – 53.8mm	W – 65.2mm	
O – 55mm	X – 66.5mm
